TOPHER'S WEEKLY LESSON

Jesus told everyone that He's the Son of God. It's true, He really is the Son of God, but His enemies didn't believe Him. They wanted to stop Him from saying that, so they put Him on a cross. First they attached one hand to the cross. Then they attached the other hand to the cross. Then they attached His feet to the cross. Jesus stayed on the cross for six hours and then He died. Jesus Is Alive (Response to God Activity) Supplies: GO! Home Guide and crayons

Directions: Give each child a GO! Home Guide and some crayons or markers. The sheet will have a space for children to draw. Tell the children to draw a picture of a sad face. While they're drawing, ask the children to talk about what makes them sad.

Question: If you could tell your friend about Jesus, what would you say?

Question: Jesus is alive! Why do you think that is such good news?

Say: Today we learned that we can tell everyone that Jesus is alive. Let's say a prayer and ask Jesus to help us tell our friends about Him.

Prayer: Begin by asking if any of the children would like to pray. Allow any children who want to pray the opportunity to do so. When they're finished, close the prayer by asking Jesus to help each of the children tell their friends and family that He is alive.
