2. The Father welcomes our vulnerability in prayer. What’s the hardest part about prayer for you?
3. The glory of God creates humility in us. Is there an area of your life where you need humility?

IDEAS TO LIVE SENT

Attempt a mini-retreat for prayer this week. This is an extended time of prayer for at least an hour. It can occur at various times: during a lunch break, an early morning hour, or withdrawing to a private place one evening. Praise God for who He is and what He has done. Be honest about what you and others are dealing with. Seek to focus your attention on the ONE you are praying to more than on the things you are asking.
