



Preschool Reentry 2020

For the time being, we will have **limited space by reservation only**. The max in any one room is 10 people, including adults and children. This is to control the number of children in our area, to keep numbers in classes low and allow us to keep everyone's safety and well being our priority. In registering you will have to state that you have agreed and acknowledge the [health guidelines](#). Our expectation is that you are truthful and you will adhere to those guidelines when bringing your children on campus.

The registration link will go live tomorrow, July 15th at 9:00am and you will receive a link in your email at that time to register. One form per family will be completed and you will see a list of age groups when you sign up. Once an age group is full you will **not see it** on the registration form anymore. If that happens for you, then please email me to get on the waiting list. You will have to have a reservation to attend. **No exceptions will be made.**

You will see on the registration form tomorrow about volunteering to serve. This will work how Worship Care in the past has worked with a rotation. **For your children to participate, you as the parent/guardian have to be willing to serve.** We can't provide care during this season without the help of many. If you know of any issues or concerns you have with this please reach out to me to discuss.

When you arrive, we will have your check in tickets available in your child's classroom. Be aware, this may be a **different classroom than they are normally assigned.** **We will be able to tell you what rooms to drop your children off as well as you will get a text that Sunday morning for your child's room assignment.** This is to not only to

keep class sizes low, but to not use a classroom more than once in a day to aid in disinfecting the area. Parents will not be allowed in the classroom. Drop-off will happen at the door.

We ask that just **one parent or guardian bring the child into our area**, and that same parent or guardian be the one who picks them up at the end of service. If possible, please do not bring siblings on the hallway that are not being dropped off in a preschool classroom. Kindergarten-2nd grade siblings can attend Children's Worship and 3rd grade siblings and older may attend worship with you. Whichever parent that is on the hall to drop off children **will be required to have a mask on**.

For our younger children that require diaper bags and extra supplies, we ask that you keep these items to a minimum and **bring them in a large Ziploc bag with their name on it**. If at all possible, please leave car seats and strollers in your vehicle. One or two diapers, a pacifier, and a possible bottle should be all that is needed during the hour we have your child.

All of our volunteers will be asked to **wear a mask** and adhere to the same health guidelines that we are asking you as parents to adhere to. If you would like your child to wear a mask, please make sure they are comfortable and know how to leave it on. We can't be responsible for making sure children keep their mask on.

Volunteers and children will **not travel outside the classroom** during the worship hour. Children will remain in the same room for the extent of their time with us on Sundays to prevent unnecessary interaction or exposure to others. We will have toys/activities that can be **cleaned and wiped down easily**.
