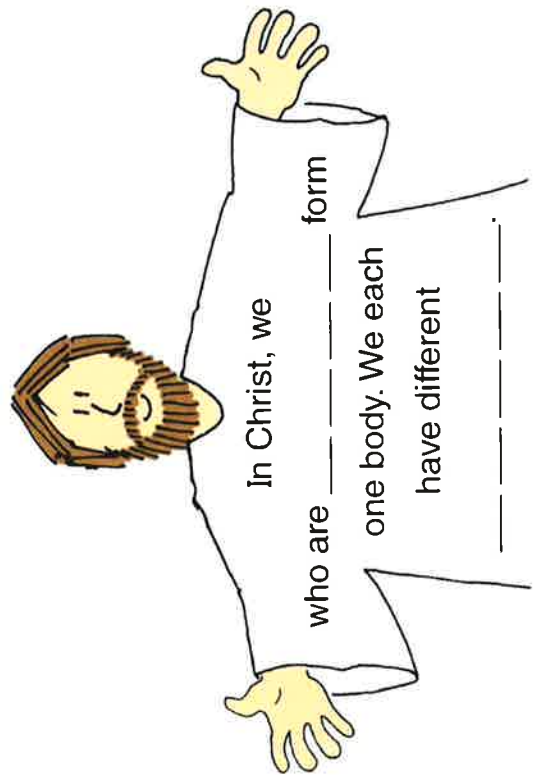


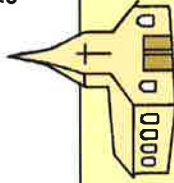
We, who are so diverse, form one body in Christ.

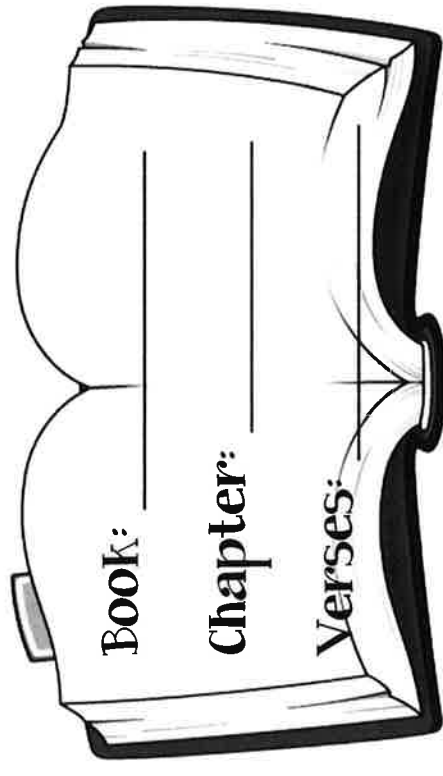
