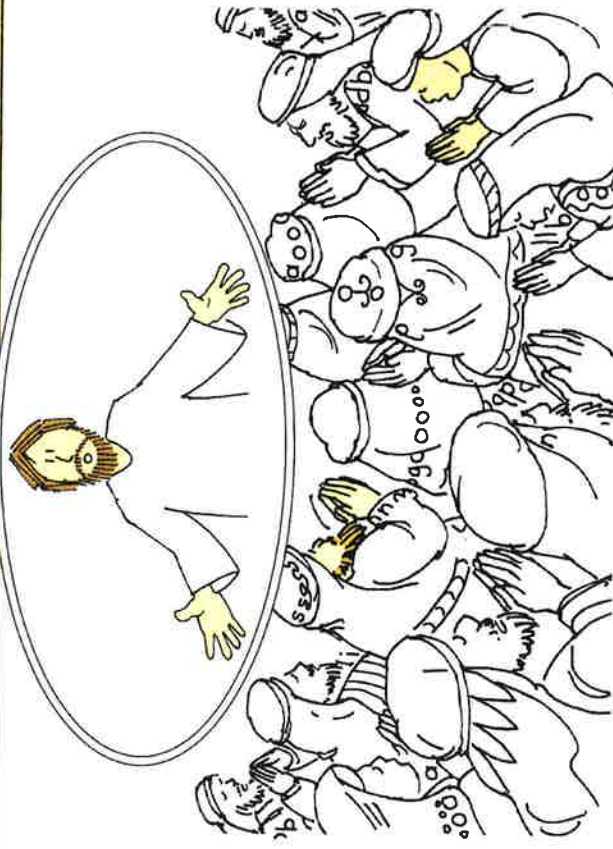


## Jesus Teaches About Prayer

Jesus taught, "When you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans (unbelievers), for they think they will be heard because of their many words."

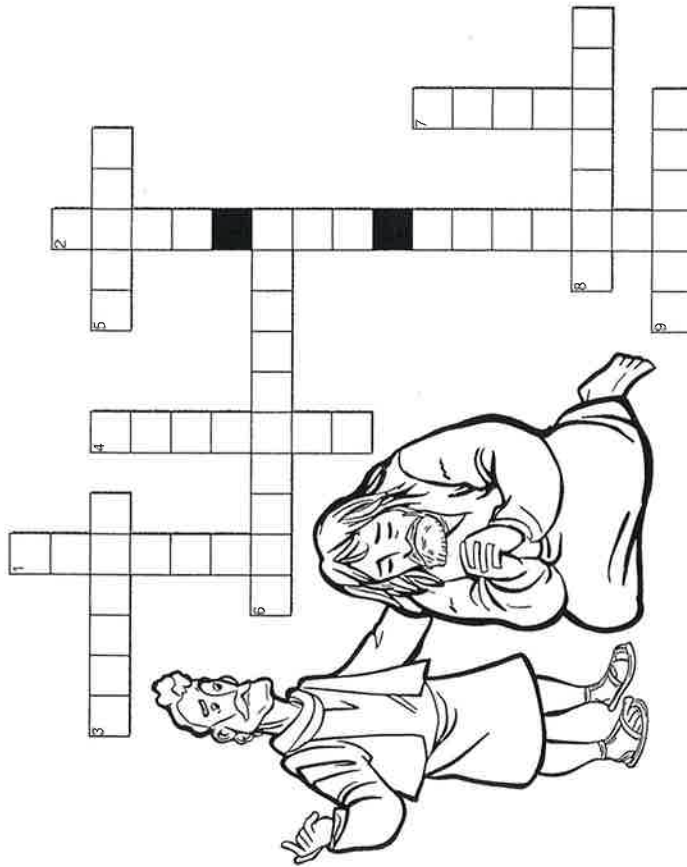
