Colossians 4:2-6

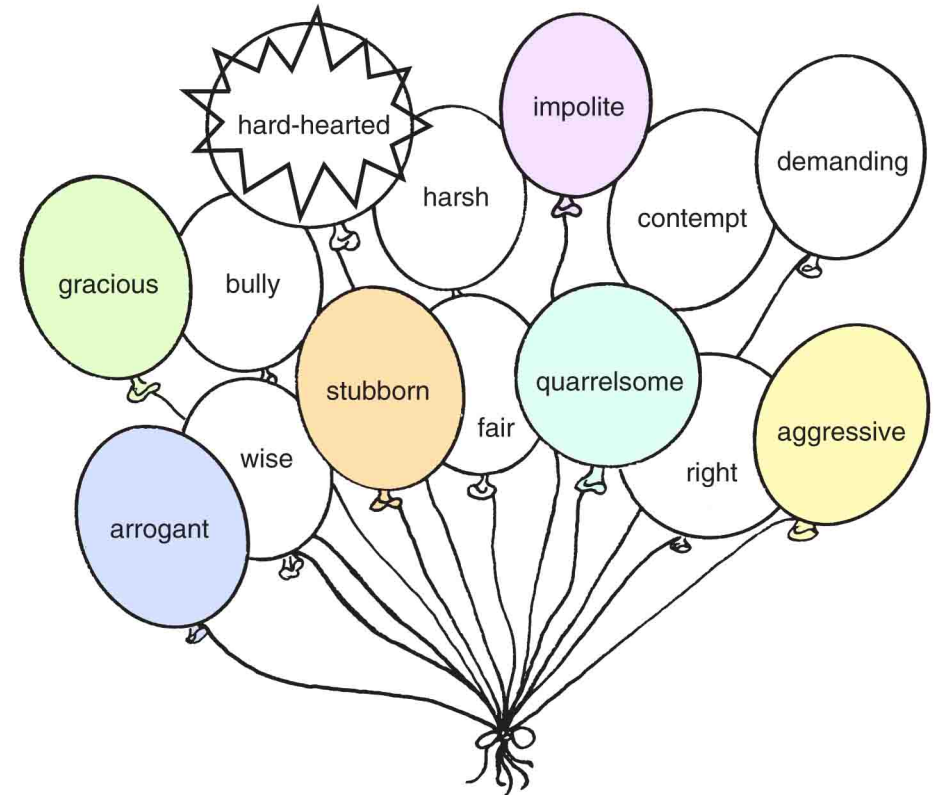

Draw a burst to pop every balloon with a word that contains 2 of the same letter. See the example below.

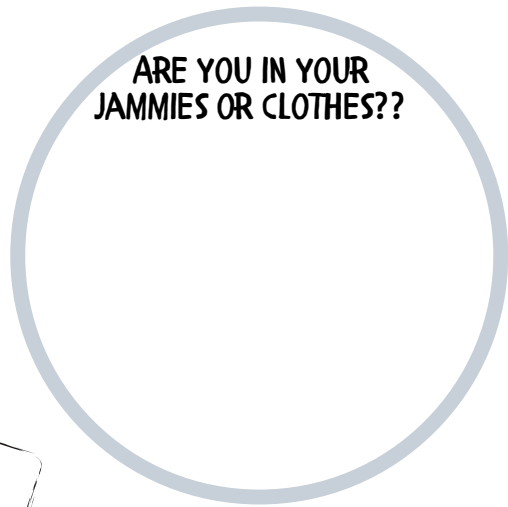
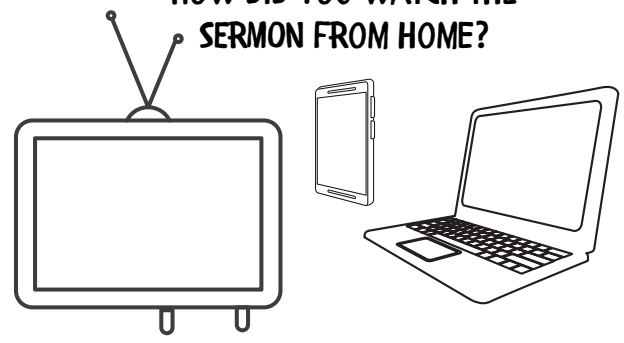
