Storytime:

Have you ever heard of a country called Spain? Spain is in Europe, all the way across the ocean. That's really far away! One of the cities in Spain is called Seville. Seville is known for its culture and art, and it is the birthplace of a special dance called "flamenco". Flamenco dancers wear beautiful clothes and dance to really cool Spanish music! And do you know what? A good friend of our church lives there! His name is Seth Graves. Seth moved to Seville not that long ago. He lives in Seville because he knew that God wanted him to go tell the people there that Jesus loves them and wants to be their friend!

Do you remember last week's lesson when we talked about the church that was planted at UAB? Seth and his team are in Seville because they want to plant a church there, just like the one at UAB! God wants people to plant churches all over the world so that His people can know Him and learn more about Him!

Activity: Let's Speak Spanish!

Let's learn a few new words in Spanish!

Hola = hello

Good Morning = buenos dias

I love you= te amo

God loves you= Dios te ama
