- 1. 29 of 89 chapters (33%) within the Gospels are about Jesus' last week.
 - a. What's so important about the final days of Jesus?
- Jesus is in control. The most important week in history is highlighted by the greatest triumph in history and Jesus was in total control. And He is still in total control.
 - a. What comfort can we take from the fact that Jesus is in total control?
 - b. Is there something in your life you need to let Jesus control?
- Jesus is a bringer of peace. When a king went to war, he rode on a horse. When a king came in peace, he rode on a donkey. Jesus rode on a donkey to show that he brought peace.
 - a. How have you experienced Jesus's peace this week?
 - b. Where do you try to find peace apart from Jesus?
- 4. Jesus is the Messiah. Riding the donkey identified him with kings in the royal line of David and fulfilled several Old Testament promises.
 - a. What can we learn about God's promises from Jesus's Triumphal Entry?
 - b. Is Jesus the King of your life?
- 5. Jesus is the only one to whom we can cry "Hosanna!" (save us).
 - a. What does it mean to ask Jesus to save you?
 - b. What's the difference between Jesus and other world religions?
