



Tuesday, 9:15 a.m. Led by Bonnie Shields: CLC Fireside Room Begins September 3




Tuesday Night, 6:30 p.m. Led by Pat Musselwhite; CLC Fireside Room Begins August 13







### Tuesday, 9:15 a.m. Led by Bonnie Shields; CLC Fireside Room Begins January 7


