# Life is Sacred Genesis 1:27, 2:7; Psalm 32:5

## I. LIFE IS SACRED BECAUSE WE ARE CREATED IN THE IMAGE OF GOD (Genesis 1:27; 2:7)

# Genesis 1:27, "So God created man in his <u>own image</u>, in the <u>image of God</u> he created him; male and female he created them."

God's "image" as a spiritual, moral, intellectual, immortal being who can communicate and have fellowship with God.

A. <u>All other creatures were created by divine command but</u> <u>humans were created by the personal creative work of God</u>. (Genesis 2:7)

## Genesis 2:7, "Then the LORD God <u>formed</u> the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

- B. Man was created with a capacity to relate to God.
- C. <u>Only humans were inbreathed with the breath of God</u>. (Genesis 2:7b)

Job 33:4, "The Spirit of God has made me; the breath of the Almighty gives me life."

# **II. LIFE BEGINS AT CONCEPTION**

# A. The Bible teaches it:

1. <u>We are set apart before we are formed in the womb</u> (Jeremiah 1:5)

Jeremiah 1:5 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations." 2. <u>We are sinful from conception</u> (Psalm 51:5)

Psalm 51:5, "Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me."

3. <u>Our personhood is affirmed while yet in the mother's womb</u> (Ps 139:13-16)

# Psalm 139:13-16 (NLT)

<sup>13</sup> You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother's womb.
<sup>14</sup> Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it.
<sup>15</sup> You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion, as I was woven together in the dark of the womb.
<sup>16</sup> You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book.
Every moment was laid out

before a single day had passed.

4. <u>There is no distinction between humanity/personhood of the</u> <u>pre-born and born</u> (Luke 1:44; 2:12)

# Vs 44, "For behold when the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the <u>baby</u> in my womb leaped for joy!"

The Greek word *brephos* is used to mean: "a preborn child, embryo, fetus, a new born child, an infant, a babe."

# B. Science affirms that a baby is genetically complete at conception

## Life begins at conception and the embryo is a human being.

#### III. LIFE IS SACRED ... MAKE WISE CHOICES

A. <u>Maintain sexual purity</u>

#### I Corinthians 6:18-19, "Flee sexual immorality. Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you?"

- B. If you get pregnant outside of marriage
- 1. Tell your parents / tell me as your pastor or talk to another staff member
- 2. Talk to a Pregnancy Resource Center (Sav-A-Life)
- 3. Choose Life: keep the baby or place the baby for adoption.
- C. If you have had an abortion
- 1. Repent and claim God's forgiveness (Psalm 32:5)

<u>Psalm 32:5</u> "I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,' and you forgave the iniquity of my sin."

Hosea 2:14-15 - God's mercy on Israel <sup>14</sup> "But then I will win her back once again. I will lead her into the desert and speak tenderly to her there. <sup>15</sup> I will return her vineyards to her and transform the Valley of Trouble into a gateway of hope.

- 2. Go to post-abortion counseling and/or Bible study
- D. The Church: Commit to help the life of the newborn
