**READ MATTHEW 28:16-20**

**Jesus gives us our One Mission**

**A. The Authority of His Person (vs. 18)**

*Philippians 2:9-11, “Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”*

- *Don't settle for the temporary at the expense of the eternal*

**C. The Assurance of His Presence and Power (vs. 20b)**

*II Peter 3:9, “The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.”*

## **D. The Adaptability of Your Plan (I Corinthians 9:19-23)**

Put I Corinthians 9:19-23 ESV on the screen

1. *Step into their world; see from their point of view*
2. *Don't compromise the message!*
3. *Keep your bearings in Christ; don't lower your standards.*

### **1 Corinthians 9:19-23 – The Message**

***“Even though I am free of the demands and expectations of everyone, I have voluntarily become a servant to any and all in order to reach a wide range of people: religious, nonreligious, meticulous moralists, loose-living immoralists, the defeated, the demoralized—whoever. I didn't take on their way of life. I kept my bearings in Christ—but I entered their world and tried to experience things from their point of view. I've become just about every sort of servant there is in my attempts to lead those I meet into a God-saved life. I did all this because of the Message. I didn't just want to talk about it; I wanted to be in on it!”***
