"One Union" Mark 10:2-9

Read Mark 10:2-9

Deuteronomy 24:1, "When a man takes a wife and marries her, if then she finds no favor in his eyes because he has found some indecency in her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce and puts it in her hand and sends her out of his house, and she departs out of his house..."

God's Intention for Marriage

- 1. <u>Marriage is to be between a man and a woman; there are no provisions for same sex marriage.</u> (vs. 6-8)
- 2. The marriage relationship takes priority over the relationship of mother and father (vs. 7)
- 3. The oneness of the husband and wife is beyond any other human relationship (vs. 8)
- 4. Marriage is a lifelong union (vs. 8b-9)

Jesus focuses on two aspects of marriage: **exclusive and permanent.**

5. <u>Marriage illustrates the relationship between Christ and the church (Ephesians 5:31-32)</u>

Ephesians 5:31-32, "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³² This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church."

- 1. Husbands love your wife sacrificially and continually as Christ loves the church.
- 2. Wives graciously submit to your husband's leadership as the church submits to Christ.
- 3. Love one another and serve one another as Christ modeled (Philippians 2:5-8)
