I. God hates pride.

Psalm 101:5, “Whoever secretly slanders his neighbor, him I will destroy; No one who has a haughty look and an arrogant heart will I endure.”

Proverbs 16:5, “The LORD detests all the proud of heart. Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished.”

II. Pride leads to destruction
