I Peter 2:4-6

- I. As "living stones" we are built up in this spiritual house:
- 1. To be a holy priesthood
- 2. <u>To offer spiritual sacrifices</u>

Worship is an encounter with God resulting in a response to God's love.

a) Sacrifice of Person (Romans 12:1)

Romans 12:1 "I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship."

b) Sacrifice of Praise (Hebrews 13:15)

Hebrews 13:15, "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise-the fruit of lips that confess his name."

II. As "living stones" we are to respond to God's love by giving Him our love.

Mark 12:30, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength."

1. Worship is focusing my attention on God [mind]

Psalm 139:1-3, "You have looked deep into my heart, Lord, and You know all about me. You know when I am resting or when I am working. You notice everything I do and everywhere I go.

- 2. Worship is expressing my affection to God [heart/soul]
- 3. Worship is using my abilities for God [strength]

Colossians 3:23, "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as though you were working for the Lord and not for people."
