# Deuteronomy 21:23, "...anyone who is hung on a tree is under God's curse."

III. The Comeback of Jesus was Miraculous (vs. 40-41)

Psalm 73:26, "My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, <u>but God</u> remains the strength of my heart; he is mine forever."

## IV. The Consequences of Jesus' Resurrection are Eternal

1. <u>Atoned for our sins</u> (vs. 43b)

"Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, 'Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree" - Galatians 3:13.

2. <u>Appointed as judge of the living and the dead</u> (vs. 42b)

Acts 17:31, "God has set a day when he will judge the world's people with fairness. And he has chosen the man Jesus to do the judging for him. God has given proof of this to all of us by raising Jesus from death." (CEV) "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man comes to the Father except through Me. "

V. The Call of Jesus is Inclusive (vs. 43)

"You've said it yourself. However, I will tell you this. Hereafter you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of power, coming on the clouds of Heaven."
